We had a great kickoff for our BYG program for the year! Thanks to all of the youth and parents that helped to make it a success. The BYG will be changing their meeting times on Sunday evenings to **3-4:30pm** so that all of our youth get a chance to participate.

We have a few activities and projects coming up:

- **Sunday, October 1**: We will be meeting at Richard and Karen Hall's house to begin working on the fair float for the parade on October 16th. They live at **1754 Lowground Road, Guyton 31312.** We will be working in Mr. Richard's shop. Work will begin at 3pm and we will plan to stay until 7pm. We will have a devotion and everyone can bring a favorite snack to share. The drinks will be provided. If anyone is not sure about where to go, someone will be at the church at 2:45pm so that you can follow them to their home.
- **Sunday, October 8:** This Sunday falls during the Fall break for students. This meeting is TBA.
- **Weds, October 11:** This is the **Fields of Faith** Event at ECHS Rebel Field at 7pm. This is sponsored by the Fellowship of Christian Athletes. It is a Christian gathering for Middle Schoolers and High Schoolers. We will meet at BLC at 6pm and travel to ECHS for the event. If you choose to meet us there, just let Mrs. Leslie know, so that we can sit together as a youth group.
- **Sunday, October 15:** We will have regular Bible Study- **Use What You Have Where You Are**. We will be packing 60 Blessing Bags for the Fair workers that travel with the Carnival. The youth will have a box out in the foyer area of the church to collect: Male and Female socks, toothbrush, toothpaste, dental floss, snacks (peanut butter crackers, small bags of chips, etc.),mints, chapstick, small first aid kits, comb, brush, shampoo, deodorant, sunscreen. These need to be travel size to fit in a gallon size zip-loc bag. We will also be placing a small Bible and encouraging note from Bible Lutheran Church in the bags.We want them to know that God loves them and we care for them as well.
- **Mon, October 16:** Fair Parade 5pm. Meet on Madison Street no later than 4:30pm. Everyone is encouraged to walk with us--all ages! We will be handing out Bibles and coloring books to share the love of Jesus. We are collecting candy to hand out on the parade route. More information to come.
- **Sunday, October 22:** BYG will participate in a Mission activity with Hosanna's Helpers MInistry@ Forsyth Park from 2-4pm. More information to come about lunch plans for that Sunday.
- **Sat., October 28:** Trunk or Treat @ BLC 5-7pm. Youth will help monitor games and bouncy house. We will be serving good old fashioned hotdogs grilled by our own personal chefs, the MOB. There will be a chili cook off competition for the men of the church to be judged by some of our GRITS women's group. We are collecting candy for this event and can be placed in the box in the church foyer.
- Sunday, October 29: Bible Study- Through a Glass Darkly and of course food and games.
