Join us as we begin construction on our 23rd home in Effingham County.

We're raising the wall on our 23rd home in Effingham County on **Saturday, October 22!** We've been preparing to build this home all summer, and we're looking forward to bringing new and experienced volunteers on board.

When: Saturday, October 22, 2022 | 8am-3pm **And Oct. 29th!**
Where: 146 4th Street Ext., Guyton, GA

Lunch will be provided for volunteers.

We will need at least 15 volunteers to complete the wall-raising, and every hand makes a difference. **All volunteers are required to register online and to digitally sign a waiver each year.**

Volunteers are needed to help "Raise the Walls" on Oct. 22nd and Oct. 29th. Volunteers will also be needed on other weekends until the project is complete and the home has been dedicated. If you are able to help with this build,

please scan the code above or go to the website habitatec.org/volunteer to complete the volunteer waiver form.

BLC will be providing sack lunches for the workers on Oct. 22nd, and volunteers are needed to prepare these. If you are available to help with lunch preparation, please contact Connie Bazemore (912) 659-2188.

There will be several opportunities to help with this mission - volunteering to participate in the build (most Saturdays, but check with Connie to make sure when the most volunteers are needed), volunteering to help at the Habitat Restore, volunteering to help with the Habitat Gala, making donations to the Habitat Restore, making monetary donations to help fund the builds, etc. Please prayerfully consider working with this mission. Remember, Habitat can give to the community only when the community gives to Habitat. Hopefully everyone will get a chance to be involved in some way with this effort. We are committed to seeing this project from start to finish!
