- As you hopefully are aware, GRITS has a fund that is used to help out various people when a disaster strikes. Most of our dollars this past year went to local people (too many fires) but we also send dollars to organizations who help those across the country and world. Our main **fundraiser** for this is a raffle. Please consider helping us out by selling the tickets or purchasing some (\$20 each). Our prizes this year are: \$500 cash, one overnight stay at the Mansion on Forsyth (\$400 value), four (4) hour inshore fishing trip for up to four (4) people, queen/king quilt made by our own quilting ladies, \$100 gift certificate from Savannah Praline Company on Tybee, and six (6) stadium seats with throws. Again - thanks to all who helped with this ministry.
