Now we **know** that whatever the law **says** it **speaks** to those who are under the law, so that **every mouth** may be stopped, and the whole world may be **held accountable** to God. For by works of the law no **human being** will be justified in his **sight**, since through the law **comes knowledge** of sin. But now the **righteousness** of God has **been manifested apart** from the law, **although** the Law and the **Prophets bear witness** to it—the righteousness of God through **faith** in **Jesus Christ** for all who **believe**. For there is no **distinction**: for all have sinned and **fall short** of the glory of God, and are **justified** by his grace as a gift, through the redemption by his blood, to be received by **faith**. This was to show God's righteousness, because in his divine forbearance he had passed over former sins.

So **Jesus** said to the Jews who had **believed** him, “If you abide in my **word**, you are **truly** my disciples, and you will **know** the truth, and the **truth will set you free**.” They **answered** him, “We are **offspring** of Abraham and have **never been enslaved** to anyone. How is it that you say, ‘You will become free?’” **Jesus** answered them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, everyone who **practices sin** is a slave to sin. The slave does not **remain** in the house forever; the **son remains forever**. So if the Son **sets** you free, you will be free **indeed**. I know that you are offspring of Abraham; yet you **seek** to kill me because my word finds no place in you. I **speak** of what I have **seen** with my **Father**, and you do what you have heard from your father.”
