- Many thanks to all who purchased or sold raffle tickets for GRITS these past few weeks. The total raised from this raffle was \$6700 - \$800 more than last year! As stated in last week's bulletin, some of these dollars have already been given to families. - Loaves and Fishes. Thanks to donations of food and the hands to prepare it, GRITS was able to fix four (4) different meals this past Monday for twenty-five families, which amounted to two-hundred and twenty-five (225) individual meals prepared. In addition, very large snack bags were fixed for each family as well as those in assisted living and/or nursing homes. Again thanks to all who helped in this ministry by preparing food, putting meals together, delivering meals, and donating snacks.
- For the last two years, GRITS has used Thrivent grants to make Christmas stockings for homeless children in Savannah. This year we will be making @80 stockings for ages 0-18 years. ELIGIBILITY

- You must reside or work in a county served by MedBank, (Bryan, Bulloch, Chatham, Effingham, Liberty, or Long).
- You must have a chronic health condition and be established under the care of prescribing, clinical provider.

 - Other Income - Alimony, Child Support, Pension, Unemployment Compensation, (For proof of Unemployment, obtain a Wage Verification Form from the Georgia Department of Labor)
