



Proposed Amendments to the Bible Lutheran Church Constitution

Amendment 1: For the purpose of clarifying our election process for council members

ARTICLE 10 - CONGREGATION COUNCIL

Current

10.03 The members of the congregation council (except the pastor) shall be elected at the annual meeting in January. A majority of the votes cast will be required for election to council. If no candidate receives a majority vote, there shall be a run-off election immediately following the first vote. The term of office shall be for three (3) years with the term of office beginning on February 1 and ending on January 31. One third (1/3) of the members shall be elected each year. Newly elected congregation council members shall be installed at worship on any Sunday prior to the date they assume office.

Altered

10.03 Three new members for the congregation council (except the pastor) shall be elected at the annual meeting in January. When there are more than three (3) candidates, voters will select up to three candidates on a ballot and the three (3) candidates with the most votes shall be elected. The term of office shall be for three (3) years with the term year beginning on February 1 and ending on January 31. Newly elected congregation council members shall be installed at worship on any Sunday prior to the date they assume office.

Amendment 2: Along with changes to our "Anti-Harassment Policy", this is to clarify our Biblical stance on indiscretions with minors

ARTICLE 3 – MINISTRY

<u>Current</u>

3.04. All youth leaders, teachers, etc. will be vetted in accordance with this constitution and by-laws.

Altered

3.04. All youth leaders, teachers, etc. will be vetted in accordance with this constitution and by-laws. We follow Jesus' words in Matthew 18:5-6 Jesus said "Whoever receives one such child in my name receives me, but whoever causes one of these little ones who believe in me to sin, it would be better for him to have a great millstone fastened around his neck and to be drowned in the depth of the sea.".

To help ensure the safety of our children, anyone found to be involved in misconduct with a minor shall have access denied to serve over minors by this congregation and will be reported to the proper authorities.
