Following worship, there will be a congregational meal for members to have an opportunity to meet the prospective pastor. Called Congregational Meeting

Bible Lutheran will hold a called congregational meeting April 7, 2024 after the morning worship service. As you know, in order to hold the meeting, a quorum (53%) of qualified voting members is required. If you are able to attend, please plan to do so. If a second meeting is required to reach a quorum, it will be held April 21 after worship. Information regarding this meeting is on the table in the hallway.

Requirements for voting. Voting members shall be eighteen (18) years of age or older and subscribe to the beliefs reflected in Bible's Constitution. In order to vote at any meeting of this congregation, the voting member shall also have: (1) attended at least one church service; (2) received Holy Communion at least once; and (3) their household has made a monetary donation to the general fund of at least \$25 during the three (3) month period prior to the scheduled meeting. It shall be the member's responsibility to make a donation of record with the financial secretary to preserve their right to vote. The Pastor and congregational council have the right to waive the financial requirement. A voting list will be established by the congregation council prior to every meeting of this congregation.
