


# THE FESTIVAL OF THE HOLY TRINITY - JUNE 12, 2022

The lessons for Trinity Sunday all point to the co-eternal nature of Jesus with the Father and the Holy Spirit. In the New Testament, Jesus is often portrayed as “wisdom,” which connects Jesus, the incarnate Word, to the creation at the beginning of time. It was upsetting to Jesus’ antagonists that he equated himself to God, even going so far as to say that before Abraham was alive, He existed.

▲ CONFESSION & ABSOLUTION (*Spoken*)

In the name of the Father, and of the †Son, and of the Holy Spirit. **Amen**

Almighty God, to whom all hearts are open, all desires known, and from whom no secrets are hid: Cleanse the thoughts of our hearts by the inspiration of your Holy Spirit, that we may perfectly love you and worthily magnify your holy name, through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen**

If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. But if we confess our sins, God who is faithful and just will forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (*Silence for reflection and self-examination*)

Most merciful God,

**we confess that we are in bondage to sin and cannot free ourselves. We have sinned against you in thought, word, and deed, by what we have done and by what we have left undone. We have not loved you with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. For the sake of your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy on us. Forgive us, renew us, and lead us, so that we may delight in your will and walk in your ways, to the glory of your holy name. Amen**

Almighty God, in his mercy, has given his Son to die for us and, for his sake, forgives us all our sins. As a called and ordained minister of the Church of Christ, and by his authority, I therefore declare to you the entire forgiveness of all your sins, in the name of the Father, and of the †Son, and of the Holy Spirit. **Amen**

The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all.  
**And also with you.**

▲ PRAYER FOR MERCY (*Sung*)

In peace, let us pray to the Lord. **Lord, have mercy.**  
For the peace from above, ... let us pray to the Lord. **Lord, have mercy.**  
For the peace of the whole world, ... let us pray to the Lord. **Lord, have mercy.**  
For this holy house, ... let us pray to the Lord. **Lord, have mercy.**  
Help, save, comfort, and defend us, gracious Lord. **Amen**

▲ Hymn of Praise (*Sung*)

Glory to God in the highest, and peace to his people on earth.  
**Lord God, heavenly king, almighty God and Father: We worship you, we give you thanks, we praise you for your glory. Lord Jesus Christ, only Son of the Father, Lord God, Lamb of God: You take away the sin of the world; have mercy on us. You are seated at the right hand of the Father; receive our prayer. For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord, you alone are the Most High, Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father. Amen**

▲ NICENE CREED *(Spoken)*

**We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.**

**We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one Being with the Father. Through him all things were made. For us and for our salvation he came down from heaven; by the power of the Holy Spirit he became incarnate from the virgin Mary, and was made man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate; he suffered death and was buried. On the third day he rose again in accordance with the Scriptures; he ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead, and his kingdom will have no end.**

**We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son. With the Father and the Son he is worshiped and glorified. He has spoken through the prophets. We believe in one holy catholic and apostolic Church. We acknowledge one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins. We look for the resurrection of the dead, and the life of the world to come. Amen**

▲ PRAYERS OF THE CHURCH *(Spoken)*

Let us pray for the whole people of God in Christ Jesus... Lord in your mercy, **Hear our prayer.**

▲ OFFERING HYMN *(Sung)*

**Let the vineyards be fruitful, Lord, and fill to the brim our cup of blessing. Gather a harvest from the seeds that were sown, that we may be fed with the bread of life. Gather the hopes and dreams of all; unite them with the prayers we offer. Grace our table with your presence, and give us a foretaste of the feast to come.**

▲ OFFERING PRAYER *(Spoken)*

Let us pray. **Merciful Father, we offer with joy and thanksgiving what you have first given us — our selves, our time, and our possessions, signs of your gracious love. Receive them for the sake of him who offered himself for us, Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen**

## HOLY COMMUNION AT THE LORD'S SUPPER

▲ GREAT THANKSGIVING TO GOD *(Sung)*

The Lord be with you. **And also with you.**

Lift up your hearts. **We lift them to the Lord.**

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God. **It is right to give him thanks and praise.**

It is indeed right and salutary....we praise your name and join their unending hymn:

**Holy, holy, holy Lord, Lord God of pow'r and might: Heav'n and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna in the highest. Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest.**

▲ INSTITUTION OF THE SACRAMENT *(Spoken)*

Blessed are you, Lord of heaven and earth. In mercy for our fallen world you gave your only Son, that all those who believe in him should not perish, but have eternal life. We give thanks to you for the salvation you have prepared for us through Jesus Christ. Send now your Holy Spirit into our hearts, that we may receive our Lord with a living faith as he comes to us in his holy Supper. **Amen. Come, Lord Jesus.**

▲ LORD'S PRAYER *(Spoken)*

**Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever and ever. Amen**

Almighty God, you freed your Son from the bonds of death and raised him to a new and glorious life in a display of your mighty power. Free us from all sin that we may live a new and holy life in Christ Jesus to the glory of your Holy Name; through the same Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen**

▲ SENDING HYMN - "HOLY, HOLY, HOLY" *(Sung, LBW #165)*

**Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty! Early in the morning our song shall rise to thee.  
Holy, holy, holy, merciful and mighty! God in three Persons, blessed Trinity!**

**Holy, holy, holy! All the saints adore thee, Casting down their golden crowns around the glassy sea;  
Cherubim and seraphim falling down before thee, Which wert and art and evermore shalt be.**

**Holy, holy, holy! Though the darkness hide thee, Though the eye made blind by sin thy glory may not see,  
Only thou art holy; there is none beside thee, Perfect in pow'r, in love and purity.**

**Holy, holy, holy! Lord God Almighty! All thy works shall praise thy name in earth and sky and sea.
