nor stands in the way of **sinners**, nor **sits** in the **seat** of **scoffers**;
but his **delight** is in the law of the **LORD**, and on his law he
meditates day and night. He is like a **tree planted** by **streams**
of **water** that **yields** its **fruit** in its **season**, and its **leaf** does
not **wither**. In all that he does, he **prosperes**. The wicked are
not so, but are like **chaff** that the **wind drives away**. Therefore
the wicked will not stand in the **judgment**, nor sinners in the
congregation of the **righteous**; for the **LORD knows** the way of
the righteous, but the way of the wicked will **perish**.

And he said, “The **kingdom** of **God** is as if a man should **scatter**
seed on the **ground**. He **sleeps** and **risers night** and **day**, and the
seed **sprouts** and **grows**; he **knows not how**. The **earth produces**
by **itself**, **first** the **blade**, then the **ear**, then the **full grain** in the ear.
But when the grain is **ripe**, at once he puts in the **sickle**, because
the **harvest** has come.” And he said, “With what can we **compare**
the kingdom of God, or what **parable** shall we use for it? It is like
a grain of **mustard** seed, which, when **sown** on the ground, is the
smallest of all the seeds on earth, yet when it is sown it grows up
and becomes **larger** than all the **garden plants** and puts out large
branches, so that the **birds** of the **air** can make **nests** in its **shade**.”
With many such parables he spoke the **word** to them, as they were
able to **hear** it. He did not speak to them without a parable, but
privately to his **own disciples** he **explained** everything.
