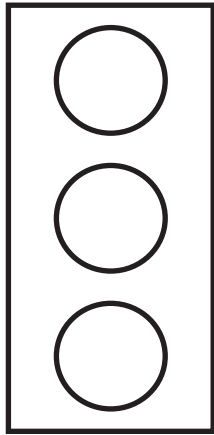

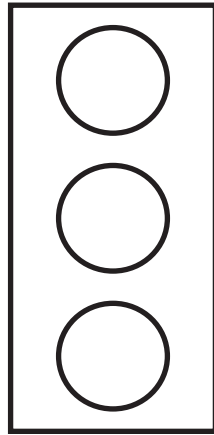

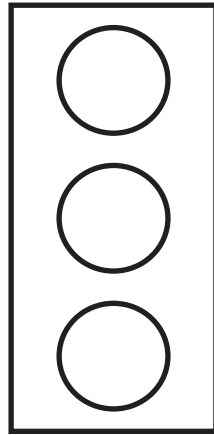
Color the picture of Jesus. Then, color each traffic light as it would glow for the following commands:

(Luke 24:49)

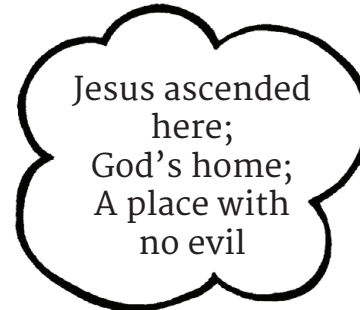

he went up through the clouds into heaven!

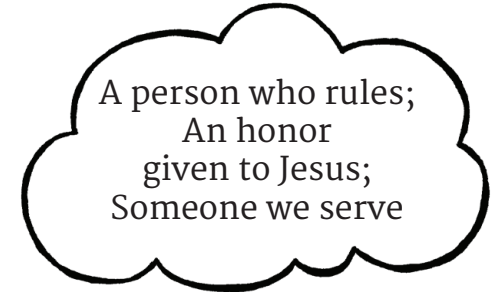

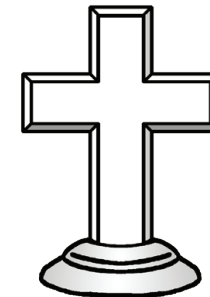
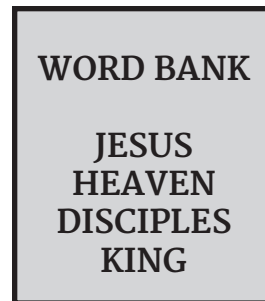
