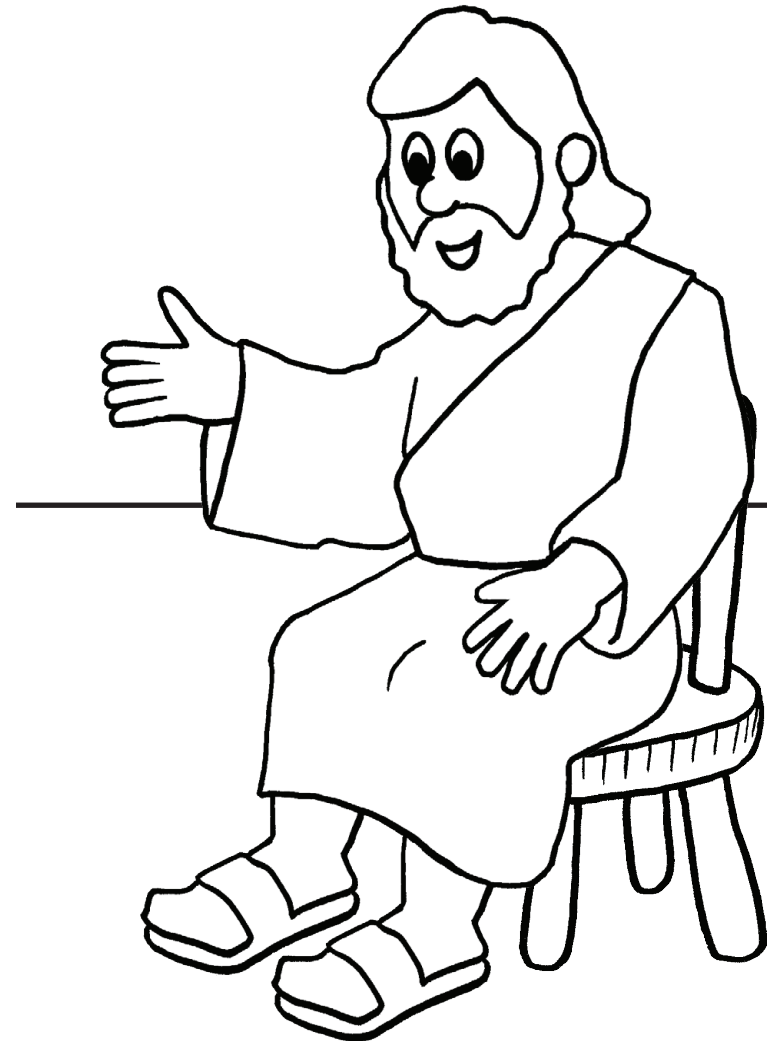

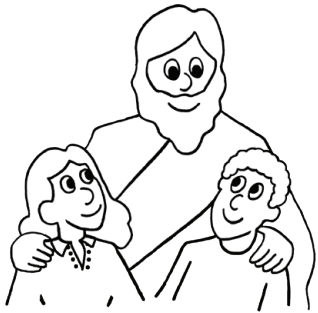
# Children's Worship Pages

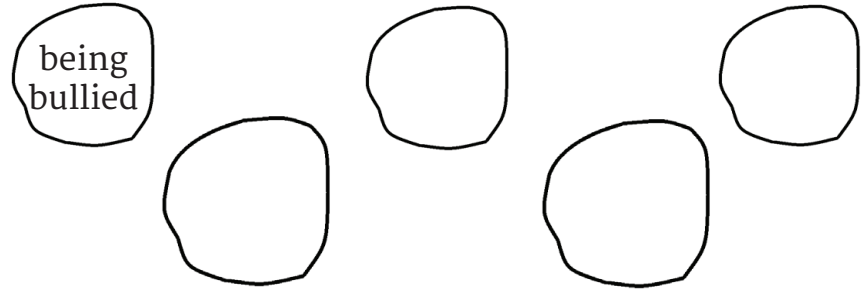
